### **How Do I Address My Legal Question?**

Please include the area of law for which you are submitting an inquiry in the subject line of your e-mail—in other words, if you have a question regarding Health Care Law please entitle your e-mail Health Care Law Question or Health Care Legal Services Needed.

After you submit your question, the Manager of the Hindu Samaj Legal Resources Network will forward your e-mail to the appropriate attorney. Shortly thereafter, you will receive an e-mail or phone call from the assigned attorney so that a legal consultation can be set up.

### **What Is the Nature of the Consultation?**

Please note that all consultations are private and fall within the attorney-client privilege; so the community lawyer—under the threat of sanction—cannot reveal the contents of the consultation to anyone. Each consultation will take 15 to 30 minutes, although a community lawyer can slightly adjust the period of the consultation according to the time needed to adequately address issue. If at the conclusion of the consultation the client requires no further assistance, then the relationship between counsel and the client has ended. If at the end of the consultation the client requires further help, the attorney will advise the client of all available options to address their legal needs.
